Song: "I Need You to Survive" HEZEKIAH WALKER Scripture: Hebrews 10:23-25

Topic: THE JOY OF FELLOWSHIP

The meteorological summer of 2023 has ended. However, the summer of 2023 for many will be remembered as the first season of full-fledged in-person gatherings since the onset of COVID. It was the summer when people were willing to leave the land of familiar and venture into the unfamiliar with other people who were unmasked with unknown COVID vaccine and booter status. It marked the summer of the "new normal."

I say "new normal" because although still a major concern for individuals with compromised immune systems, the impact of contracting the virus is typically not as severe as it was in 2019 and 2020. As we gathered in our various settings, one could observe individuals who were wearing masks, as well as others who were not. There were individuals who greeted each other with hugs while others nodded their heads or gave fist or elbow bumps. No matter the individual concerns regarding COVID, anyone present at these gatherings experienced the joy of fellowshipping with others.

Verse 25 of the above Scripture tells us to "not neglect our meeting together..." Whether this Scripture influenced the decision of our International President Dr. Jacqueline Scott and her committee to have an in person, not hybrid meeting this summer, I do not know. However, I must believe their knowledge of this Scripture had some bearing, either conscious or subconscious, on their decision to gather in Jacksonville Florida for the Women's Missionary Council Quadrennial Assembly, and for this I am grateful.

The 20th Quadrennial Assembly was a gathering where essential business was conducted, but more importantly, it was a gathering where meaningful interactions between sister missionaries and fellow believers occurred.
